Biography

Mustapha Akrim's (b. 1981, lives and works in Rabat and Sale) installations question the nature of work and the difference between construction and creating art in light of society's state of constant change. He received his diploma from the Institut National des Beaux-Arts de Tétouan in 2008 and he have his first exhibition in a museum in Morocco. Akrim has participated in workshops in Namibia, Jordan, France, and Morocco, and has also been in residence at L'appartement 22 in Rabat, where he had a solo exhibition in 2011. He is part of a generation of artists that is developing a new language with which to redefinethe basis of expression in the visual arts in Morocco. With a nuanced understanding of history and the dynamics of power,this generation searches for a new freedom in its break from the aesthetics developed in the immediate post-colonial period and after. In 2011, Akrim participated in the ViennaFair, and was selected by the Jury the LENIKUS Foundation for a 3 month scholarship in Vienna in 2012. He is also part of the exhibitio Surveillé(e)s" at, la Halle de Pont-en-Royan in France.






